



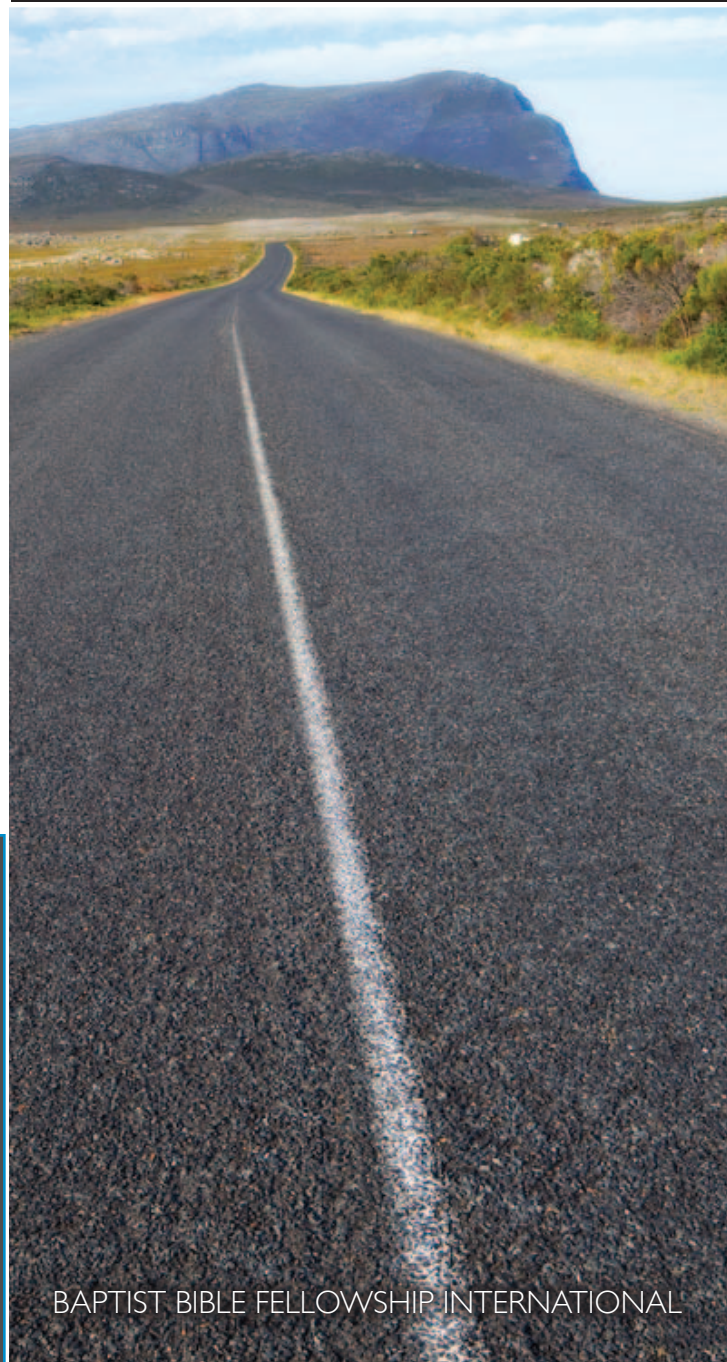
The BBFI requires a minimum of one year as a full-time staff member with a Baptist church. Internship can be a productive experience for both the intern and the internship church affiliated with the BBFI. The primary objective of the internship qualification is to ensure that the prospective missionary has achieved some level of competency in practical ministry experience before leaving for a foreign country. The Mission Office of the BBFI **does not charge approved missionaries to handle their contributions** and other services. The missionary receives 100 percent of every dollar that comes in for them.

If God is calling you to the mission field, **start by submitting a written request for an application or you may begin the application process online at www.bbfimissions.com**. Information regarding personal qualifications, including educational and other requirements may be viewed on our website as well. Upon request, the necessary application forms will be provided by the Mission Office of the BBFI. All required forms must be returned at least 90 days prior to approval at one of the BBFI National Fellowship Meeting.

Missionaries are **covered by a worldwide medical plan including medical evacuation and life insurance** through the BBFI self-funded plan.

Every missionary is **required to have a BBFI-affiliated sending church**. The local church has been given the responsibility to be the biblical sending agency for missionaries. Therefore, a missionary must be sent by a church who agrees to both send you and work with the BBFI Mission Office.
